Chair Report

- Dwight at the State Party has requested no donations at the Federal Level this year.
- The Mayor/City Council Forum was a success with 2/3 of the feedback remaining positive and 1/3 negative, mostly about the lack of tunnel related questions
- An AdHoc committee has been formed to look at way to improve relationships inside of the executive board, specifically to clear the air surrounding internal disputes going external

Discussion around using the energy and volunteer base in the 34th District to help in other contested races in King County. The conclusion was that with our own contested primary it would be better to welcome Democrats from embattled areas to visit with us to make their own requests for funding and volunteers. The idea was not entirely discarded for future conversation, but general consensus was that it wasn't the right time at the moment.

Discussion on ways to improve the members' understanding of parliamentary procedure. It was decided we would begin to put some Common Procedures on the back side of our Membership meeting agendas, and to possibly have a "Parliamentarian minute" where a specific topic is discussed each meeting briefly to increase comfort levels with Robert's Rules.
