

Minutes of the Outreach Committee Meeting, March 15, 2011.

The meeting started at 7:10pm at Mick Kelly's in Burien.

Doris reported that she contacted WestSide Baby regarding their diaper drives and that her contact for the organization was very interested in our assistance. I am to follow up to see how we can help.

Next we discussed a potential new event for the 34th: The White Center Cambodian New Year Festival on April 30th. Tamsen had brought this to my attention a few days prior, and I obtained the information packet. Due to the cost of attending this event, we felt it needed to be passed by Tim Nuse, and was subsequently approved. Since the Burien Clean Sweep falls on the same Saturday, Tamsen to be the lead for this fair. The booth will be manned jointly by members of both the Outreach and Diversity committees. We are attempting to find a member of the Khmer community to join us. Tamsen will provide signage in Cambodian, Doris to get candy, and I am to obtain voter registration forms in Cambodian.

We took up the topic of "Event Leader", and what should be expected of this position. The basic duties agreed upon for festivals are:

- 1) Have knowledge of the 34th District Democrats
- 2) Be able to set up and tear down
- 3) Contact pre-scheduled volunteers if they are absent from their prearranged shifts. It was felt that one person be in charge of scheduling booth shifts and providing lead with contact information, and that this duty should be that of the committee chair.

Tamsen volunteered to be leader of the Morgan Community Festival.

I brought in some mock-ups for a business-type card that could be used to hand out to people we meet. (See 2nd page of this PDF.) It was mentioned that it should also be formatted in such matter to allow for names to be added for fund-raising purposes, etc. I am going to do follow-up with the Communications committee for further input.

We have not learned yet if the BOOM (Be Our Own Movement) youth event will be held this year. Les is to contact the DNDA to get information on it.

I proposed that we arrange a food drive in conjunction with the White Center Food Bank. It was agreed that I pursue this.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30.

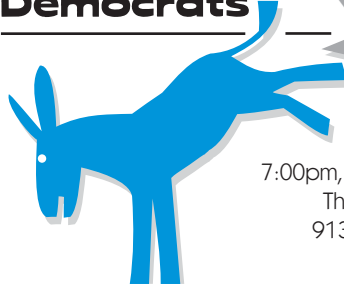
