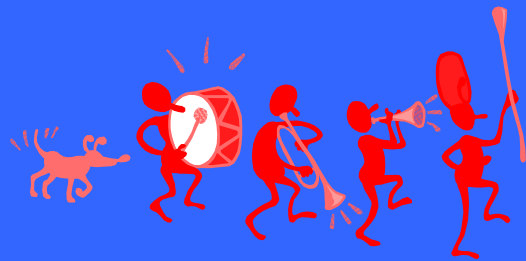


Academic Excellence Parade Saturday, October 21, 2006 at 10:00 a.m.
