

"Extra-Sovereign Non-Governmental Agencies" Act

The people find and declare

WHEREAS, The State of Washington recognizes the opportunities afforded by trade both in the Americas and overseas; and

WHEREAS, The State of Washington has a long and distinguished history of trade in both materials, finished goods and services; and

WHEREAS, The State of Washington recognizes the value of trade both for our economy and the economies of other Sovereign States; and

WHEREAS, The State of Washington has as it's responsibilities, the fair and safe treatment of its work force, responsible use of its resources and protection of its environment; and

WHEREAS, The State of Washington is as a part of a sovereign nation constrained by labor and environmental laws as dictated by the Congress of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, The State of Washington as a duly established State within the Union must follow its own labor and environmental laws as dictated by the Senate and Assembly of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, The People of Washington are not obliged to recognize the influence or legal authority of an Extra Sovereign Body which does not represent a Sovereign Trading Nation but private corporate entities, which have sought to circumvent the laws of either legal Sovereign bodies of the United States of America or the Great State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, The People of Washington have recognized that the Extra Sovereign Body known as World Trade Organization has by either influence or unrecognized legal authority sought to circumvent the laws relating to Washington State's legal protections of workers, Washington State's protection of the environment and Washington State's management of its own resources and productivity; and

WHEREAS, The People of Washington have recognized that to allow an Extra Sovereign Body known as the World Trade Organization to exercise influence or an unrecognized legal authority on the Great State of Washington, will have a potential impact on our security as a legal Sovereign entity;


43 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the People of the State of Washington, that the
