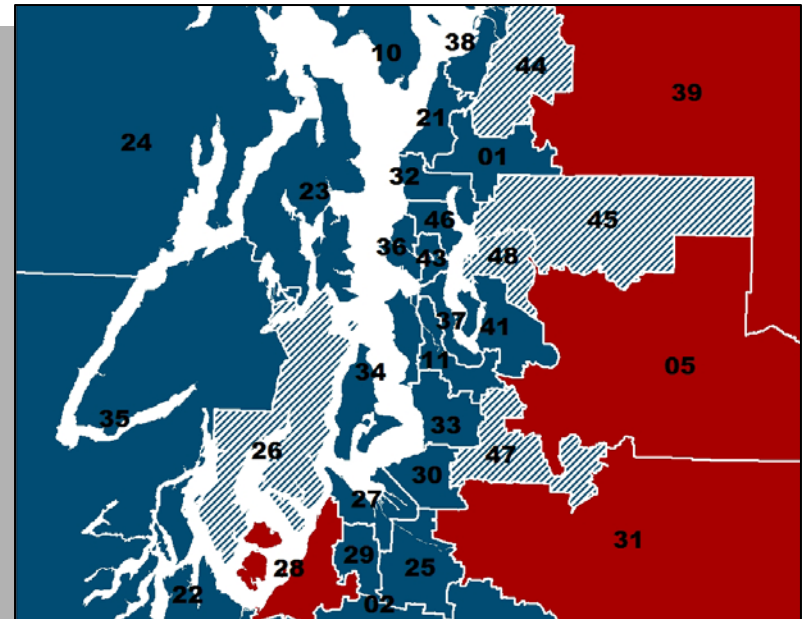

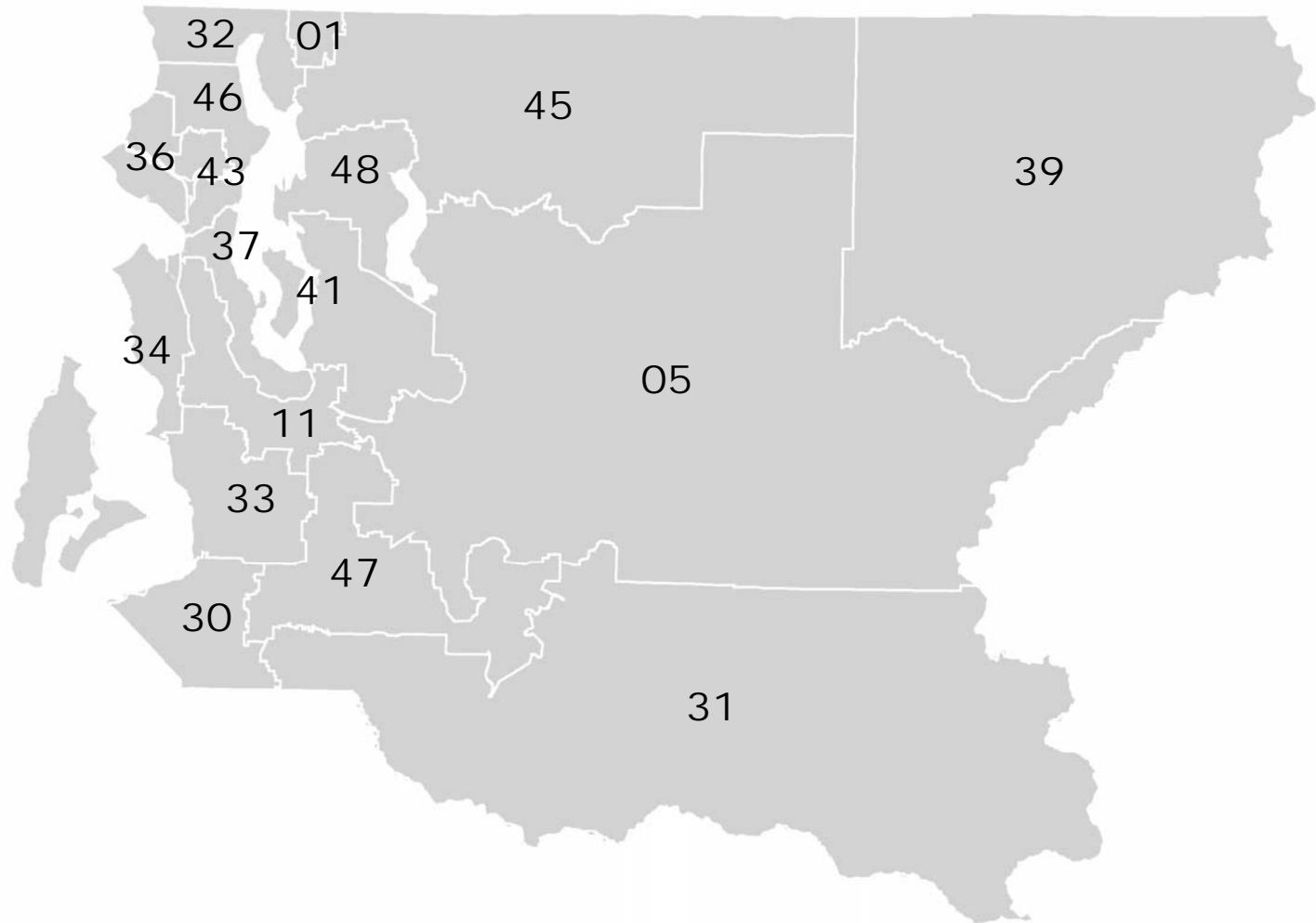

Voter Registration & Turnout

Key Findings

- A majority of Washington voters live in King (30%), Pierce (11%) and Snohomish Counties (10%)
- Counties with the lowest voter registration rates generally are in Central WA and have large Latino populations (Yakima, Grant)
- Statewide turnout in 2006 was significantly higher (65%) than other recent mid-term elections
- Regionally, turnout was highest in the Peninsula (69%) and lowest in South Puget Sound (59%)

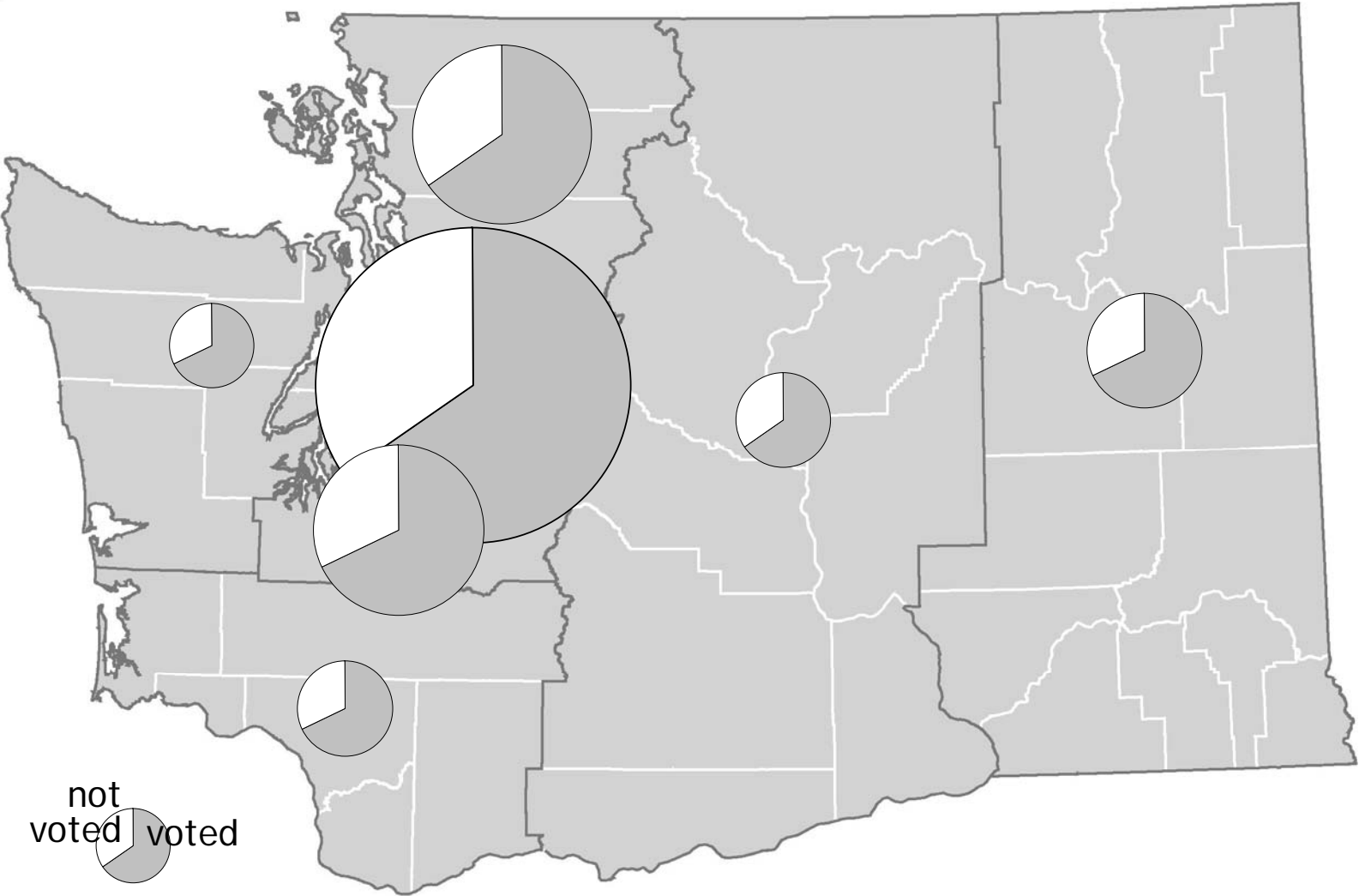


Voter Registration & Turnout

Key Findings (cont'd)

- Seattle registered voters account for more than 1/3 of all those in King County. Next largest are Bellevue (6%), Federal Way (4%), Kent (3%) and Shoreline (3%)
- Legislative districts in the Seattle region had the highest (36th & 46th LDs) and lowest (11th LD) turnout levels
- King County Council District #4 had the highest turnout (71%) and most numbers of ballots cast

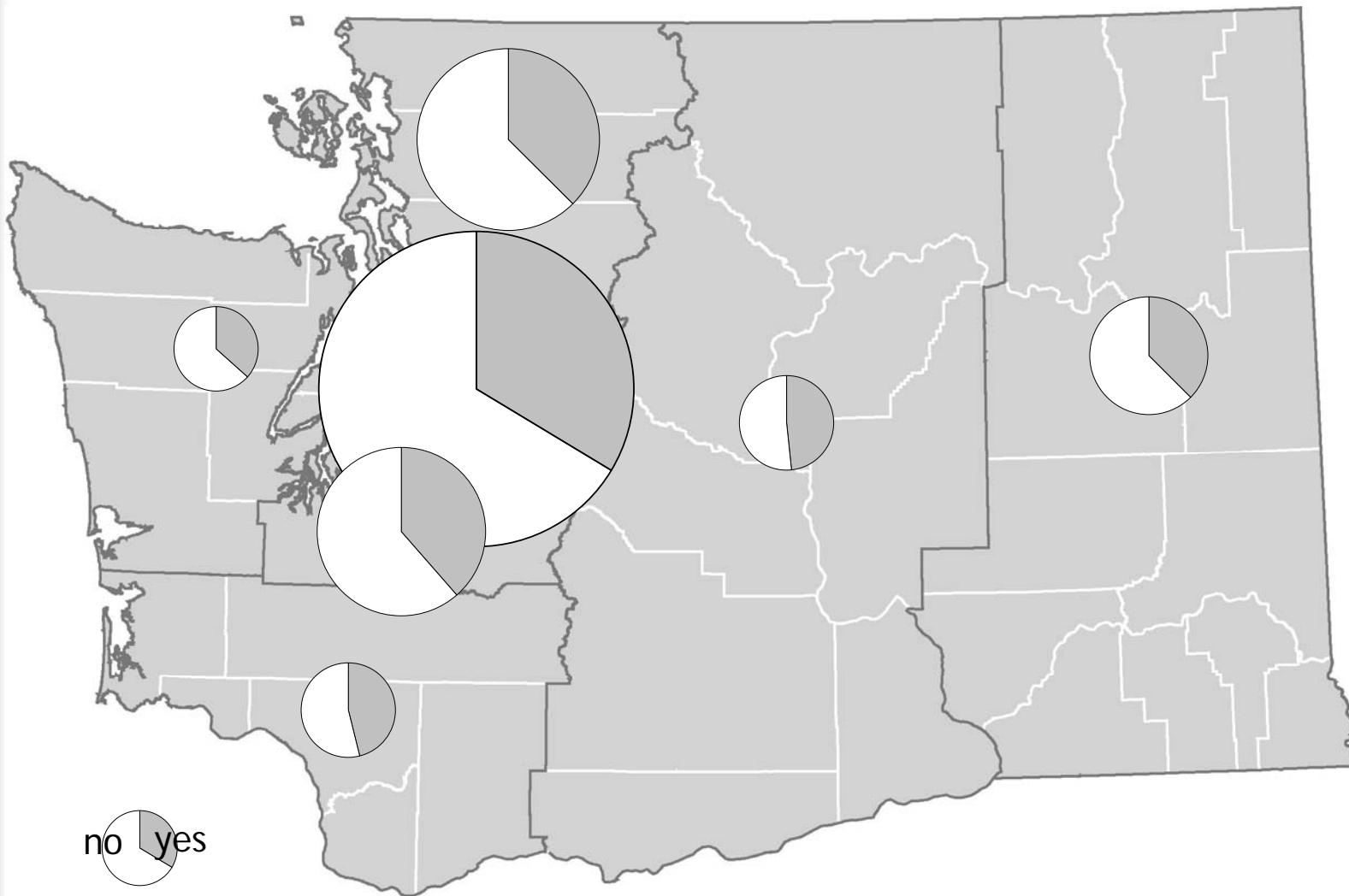
I-920: Estate Tax Repeal

Key Findings

- Benton, Franklin and Yakima were the only counties to vote for I-920
- Whitman, Grays Harbor and Jefferson Counties voted against I-920 by more points than King
- In King County, Seattle and Shoreline voters rejected I-920 by highest rates. Only the “Points” communities voted in favor
- The King County legislative districts most opposed to I-920 were the 43rd (81%), 37th (78%) and the 36th and 46th (77%)

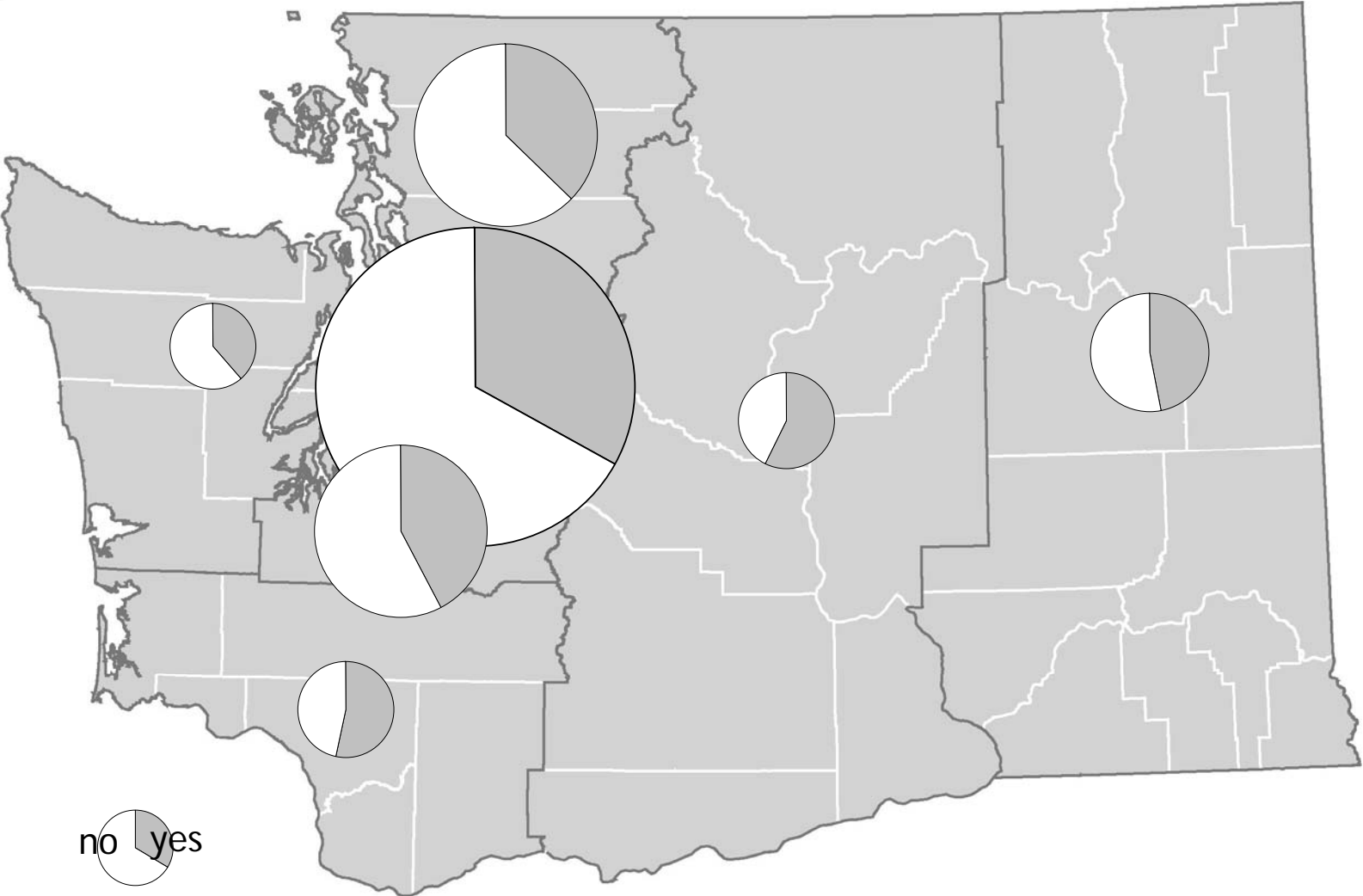


I-933: Property Rights

Key Findings

- A majority of counties in Central, Eastern and Southwest WA voted against I-920 and for I-933
- In King County, the cities most opposed to I-933 were Seattle (78%), Shoreline and Lake Forest Park (77%). Voters in rural East and South King County were mostly likely to support it.
- In terms of King County legislative districts, the most opposition came from the 43rd (81%), the 36th and the 46th (79%). The only LD to favor I-933 was the 31st.

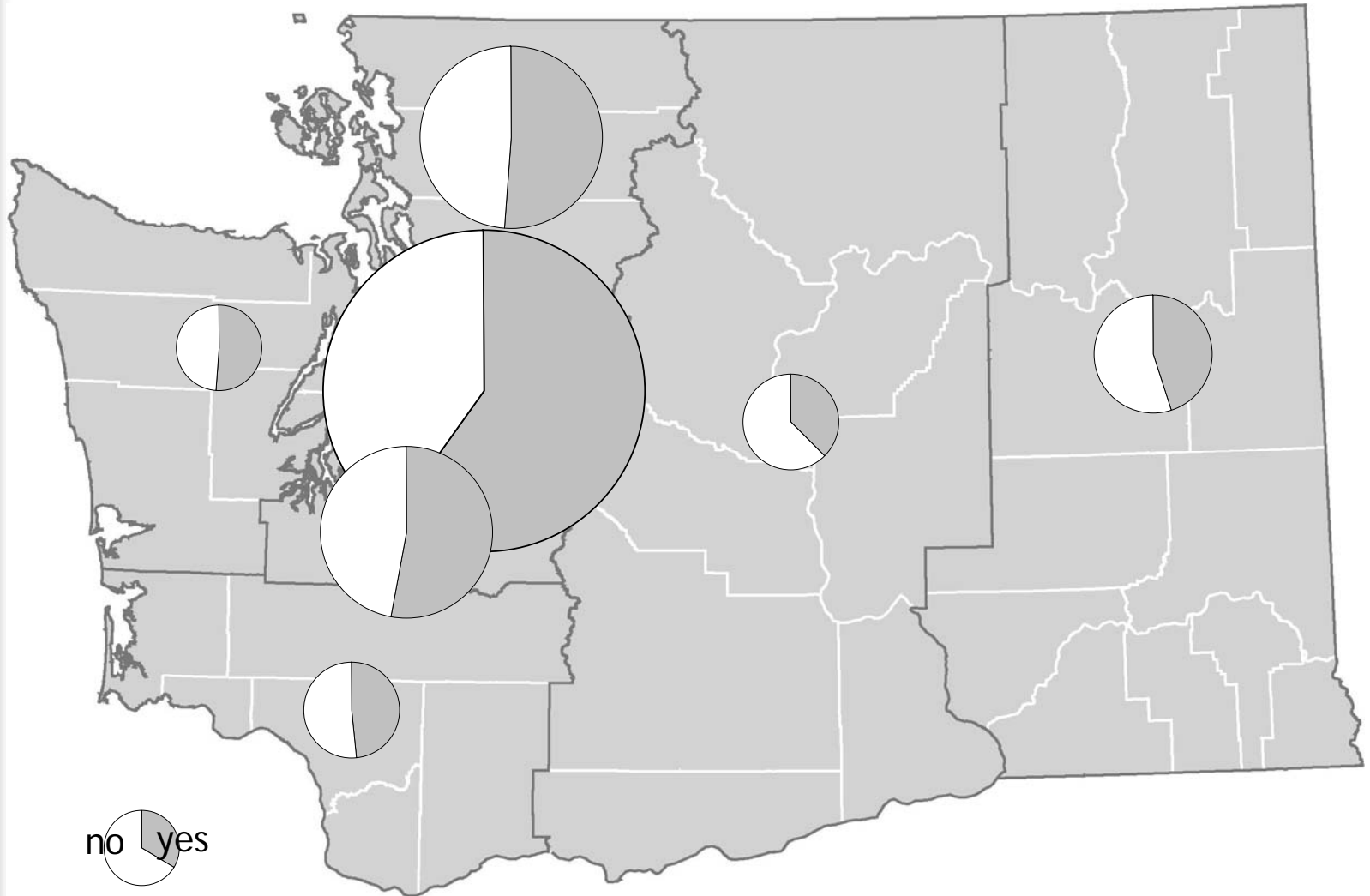
I-937: Renewable Energy

Key Findings

- I-937 was largely split along the Cascades with 19 of 20 counties in Central and Eastern WA opposing it and 15 of 19 counties in Western WA favoring it
- Seattle, Shoreline and Lake Forest Park led the support for I-937 in King County. Eight of 16 South King County cities rejected the measure.
- King County voters in the 31st and 47th LD narrowly opposed I-937. The 43rd LD support it by a 4-to-1 margin.
