A Happy Ending on the Lora Lake Apartments

As most of you will recall, we passed a resolution last May concerning preservation of the Lora Lake Apartments as affordable housing. Seventy-two units of this complex were located in the Runway Protection Zone and have already been torn down, but the other 162 are outside of the zone. King County Housing Authority had operated the complex under an agreement with the Port which bought Lora Lake to use as a buffer zone for the third runway until the it was completed, at which time the complex would be demolished and the land used for commercial activity.

After pressure from Ron Sims, a lawsuit filed by the King County Housing Authority to take the Lora Lake Apartments using the power of eminent domain, and negotiations with



Dave Upthegrove and Frank Chopp, an agreement has finally been reached. A Memorandum of Understanding was approved by the Burien City Council by a 4 to 2 vote on November 5 calling for the King County Housing Authority to purchase the Lora Lake Apartments from the Port of Seattle. 34th District members Sue Blazak, Jack Block Jr, Lucy Krakowiak and Mayor Joan McGilton voted to approve the Memorandum. The City Council approved the

agreement on the condition that the city wouldn't be held responsible if Lora Lake residents sue over noise or pollution, although other residences are closer to the flight path and there has been no discussion of tearing them down.

This is a big victory for housing advocates who had argued that the Port's plan to demolish the complex for commercial use was at odds with the County's Plan to End Homelessness. Much of the credit goes to our own Cherisse Luxa. Cherisse stubbornly kept at it and continued coordinating with the Housing Authority and Council of Churches and mobilizing the PCOs in Burien. She was tireless. Hats off to you, Cherisse.

Why a Primary When We Have Caucuses?

That's a question we have been hearing a lot lately. Back in 1989, after the Republicans were embarrassed by the religious right takeover of their caucuses when the state went for Pat Robertson, an initiative was approved by the people and then passed by the Legislature calling for a presidential primary. But while it called for a primary, it did not require the parties to choose their delegates based on it. In 2004, neither Republicans nor Democrats chose their delegates from the primary and the primary was cancelled.

This year, Republicans are selecting a little less than half of their delegates from the primary and the rest from caucuses. The DNC has required the Washington State Democrats to choose one or the other: caucus or primary. The state party has chosen to continue with the caucus system. Remember, any Democrat can attend and be actively involved in their caucus. This is grass roots politics at its best. Many of our members have had their first involvement with the party at a caucus that a friend or their PCO talked them into attending.

While it's theoretically possible for special interest groups to take over our caucuses like happened to the Republicans in 1988, it is highly unlikely because we are advertising our caucuses better than in 1988, and the attendance at the 2004 was huge, and we expect even higher attendance in 2008. With numbers like we had it's pretty hard for a special interest to take hold.

It is each party's right to choose its own candidates. In Washington's primary, a Democrat can vote for a Republican and vice versa. In 2004 some people, not any of us of course, but other people, chose a Republican ballot because one candidate was completely despicable (Bush) so they voted for the lesser of two evils (McCain) on the off chance that a Republican won. While we might like doing that to Republicans we don't want Republicans doing that to us, and it didn't work out all that well anyway.

So, since no Democratic delegates are chosen from the primary, go ahead and take that Republican ballot and pick the least despicable candidate, assuming there is one.

A huge victory was scored in Burien when a resolution to save the Lora Lake Apartments was passed. Kudos to Cherisse Luxa for keeping the pressure on the Port and the Burien City Council.

Ivan and Representative Sharon Nelson visited the 45th District and spoke to urge support for efforts to contain Maury Island strip mining. The 45th District Dems have passed a motion in support of that position.

Institute for a Democratic Future

Olivia Robinson represented the Institute for a Democratic Future speaking about their goal of developing and promoting civic leaders in Washington state. Bylaws

Allan Munro suggested that Section 6.a., removing the requirement for a one month membership before voting on resolutions, was confusing. The motion was amended to use the same language on membership requirements for resolutions as that in the section on endorsements: *Only members in good standing by the end of the prior month's meeting may vote, except that any member who had paid dues in the previous calendar year may vote if the membership is renewed at or before the meeting.* The Motion passed.
