Number of Delegates Supporting each presidential preference:

Clinton is supported by 228 delegates or 24.62%.

Obama is supported by 689 delegates or 74.41%.

Uncommitted is supported by 9 delegates or .97%.

The Obama and Clinton campaigns have reached the 15% threshold.

If the allocation of Delegates and Alternates were made at this time, not considering the 15% threshold:

Clinton would receive 12 Delegates and 6 Alternates

Obama would receive 35 Delegates and 18 Alternates

Uncommitted would receive 0 Delegates and 0 Alternates

Clinton is supported by 28 delegates or 38.36%.
