

**White Center Food Bank  
Resolution for Support**

Whereas the White Center Food Bank (WCFB) serves the poorest neighborhood in King County and is in unincorporated KC, therefore not receiving funding from Seattle or any other city,

Whereas the number of families supported by WCFB has grown from 1,005 to 1,307 in the past year,

Whereas the FEMA budget has been cut 30%, equating to a \$9000 loss of funds for WCFB in 2006,

Whereas the 34<sup>th</sup> District Democrats support the core values of equitable treatment of all people and providing people the opportunity to reach their highest potential,

Whereas the 34<sup>th</sup> District Democrats support the WCFB with resources including food, time, and money,

Be it resolved that the 34<sup>th</sup> District Democrats urge Governor Gregoire to sign the bill providing necessary funding to the WCFB,

Be it further resolved that the 34<sup>th</sup> District Democrats request urgent financial support from King County to support their most dire needs,

Be it further resolved that the 34<sup>th</sup> District Democrats request the King County Executive to do everything in his reach to afford the WCFB with critical funding to allow the WCFB to continue supporting the most needy in King County.
